NEW POSTINGS AND TRANSFERS

Our Vidyalaya got its first permanent appointment of teachers in the month of May 2016. Smt. Asha O V (TGT English), Smt. Rakhi Kumari (TGT Maths), Smt. Sudha Rawat(PRT. Music) joined in May 2016. Then the following Primary teachers Smt. Lovely Thomas from K V No.1 Naval Base, Smt. Reena Paul Palal from K V PT Cochin, Smt. Gorette Betty from K V No.2 Naval Base, and Smt . Mary George from RB Kottayam were transfered to this Vidyalaya in July. Smt. Saritha M .R Librarian from K V Ezhimala, Smt. Saraswathy Nair, SSA from KV Adoor, Mrs. Jose Thomas, JSA from KV Kadvantara also joined our Vidyalaya family through transfer in July 2016. Principal Sri. Reji V.R Nath who was on deputation from K. V. INS Dronacharya, got regular transfer to this Vidyalaya during October 2016.

RESULTS

The academic session started on 1st April 2016 and ended at 27th March 2017.This Vidyalaya follows the CCE (Continuous & Comprehensive Evaluation) in all classes, which ensures stress free learning and removes the fear of failure from the young minds. Vidyalaya conducted formative and summative assessments for classes III to VI as per the calendar of activities for the session 2016-17. The result was declared on 27th March, 2017 with a pass percentage of 100.

CMP

Common Minimum Programme or CMP is followed in the Primary section for the quality improvement of primary education. Under CMP many programmes are arranged for the all-round development of students .Here the minimum level of learning in listening, speaking, reading and writing is achieved by each and every child. We give the needed weightage for curricular as well as co-curricular activities. Let me have a glance at the various programmes.

MATHRUSANGAMAM

Good parenting is an art which is not taught anywhere. Most of the parents are unaware of the developmental needs of their children. We firmly believe that mothers are the most influential persons in the life of a child being the role model for them in early years. Hence

mothers of students from Class 1-5 were called for a Mathrusangamam on 23.07.2016. The class teachers of the concerned classes conducted the meeting.

COMMUNITY LUNCH:

Our Vidyalaya organized a community lunch on 7/10/2016, where children shared different food items brought from home among them. This was done to enhance sharing among students and to create a friendly bond between them.

NO BAGS DAY: No bags day was celebrated on 7/10/16, which aimed at freely interacting and exhibiting their abilities. A film show on moral developing theme was conducted followed by talent show.

GRANDPARENTS' DAY CELEBRATION

Kendriya Vidyalayas uphold Indian culture in its true spirit. It teaches the students to love and respect the elders and senior citizens. As a part of that Vidyalaya celebrated Grandparents day on 16-11-2016. Grandparents were honoured by the students in meaningful ways. Grandparents shared their experience and feelings. All of them expressed their happiness by saying that it was a unique experience.

CLUSTER LEVEL COMPETITIONS

To develop sportsman spirit CLC on CCA and sports were conducted during November 2016 among various KVs in Ernakulam Region. Our children participated in all the items.

FIELD TRIP

Field trips are part of our calendar of activities. We went to **J Yes farm** Neendoor and **Amaze World** in Alapuzha.

ART AND CRAFT EXHIBITION

On 3rd February 2017 we had an exhibition of children's creative works. It was a variety of wonderful works by the students. Paper craft, origami, clay modelling, wonder from waste, models made of feathers, cotton, colour papers and topics related to science, simple experimental models etc were exhibited.

EQUIP - ENSURING QUALITY IN UPPER PRIMARY

EQUIP programme has been implemented in KVS since 2012. As per the RTE, there is automatic promotion till Class VIII. Keeping this in view, there was a dire need of maintaining as well as improving quality in VI to VIII. The difficulties of the primary students, when they reach in secondary classes to cope with 6 subjects and a new language, Sanskrit can be overcome through EQUIP.

LIBRARY

Irrespective of the limited infrastructure we give prior position to library. The Library is equipped with Reference Books, Textual Books, Journals and Dailies. We have 648 books in our library. We subscribe 7 periodicals and 4 dailies also.

We are striving hard to increase the number of books. Children are also motivated to donate books to the Vidyalaya on their birthdays. We have a library blog which can be accessed by public. All the activities of our Vidyalaya is published in this blog.

SCOUTS AND GUIDES

The Vidyalaya is registered with KVS Division of Bharat Scouts and Guides for scout-guide activities and 67 students are enrolled as Cubs & Bulbuls, Scouts & Guides under Trainers in Scouting and Guiding. Cubs & Bulbuls Utsav was celebrated on 03-12-2016. All the Cubs and Bulbuls performed various activities. Thinking day was celebrated in a befitting manner. Going up ceremony of Cubs and Bulbuls was conducted on March 1, 2017.

GUIDANCE AND COUNSELLING

Guidance and counselling were conducted from time to time for our school students by Smt. Mary George and Smt. Gorette Betty. Sense of belongingness, truthfulness, integrity etc are developed through these sessions.

Special classes were conducted for class 6 on health hygiene and adolescence by Smt Rakhi Kumari

YOGA

Yoga is a remedy in this modern mundane world. Meditation occupies an integral part of today's fast moving life. Yoga is offered as part of the curriculum for all classes. Our Morning Assembly begins with Pranayam. We had celebrated International Yoga Day on 21-06-2016. Students performed yoga under the guidance of Smt Rakhi Kumari. Teachers had a separate session for yoga.

SOCIAL SCIENCE EXHIBITION

Social Science Exhibition is meant to give students a universal outlook and global understanding. This is another area for students to show their originality and creativity. Class VI students participated in Quiz, Debate, and Album making competitions in school level. Our students of class VI gave a tight competition to the senior students of classes up to XII from other school in song and dance in cluster level.

GREEN OLYMPIAD

79 students of this school had participated in Green Olympiad. Kumari Sreelakshmi of class VI got merit certificate and all others got participation certificate.

TEACHERS EMPOWERMENT PROGRAMMES

'Teachers are also learners' staying updated is the key to success in any field especially in education. Our teachers constantly strive to stay updated by attending workshops and various training programmes.

All the permanent teachers had gone for various trainings relevant to their subjects.

CO CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES (CCA)

The school provides all opportunities to every child for his physical, moral and mental development and with this end in view "the house system" has been introduced and all the co-curricular and sports activities are organized house-wise in the school. Various individual and group competitions were organized throughout the year.

EXTERNAL COMPETITIONS AND ACTIVITIES

In order to bring out their talents, students are encouraged to participate in art and culture related activities outside the vidyalaya also. The prize winning students are felicitated in the morning assembly which is an inspiration for the students to follow suit. The paintings drawn by Kumari Anika T J, Master Alden T J, and Master Alvin T J, of class VI were published in Children's Digest and the works of Master Sreehari P J of class V Kumari Haripriya of class III, Kumari Rishika of class III, Master Immanuel of class V were published in Children's Magazine.
